- Per our meeting on 8-5-21, a site plan shall be submitted within 2-3 weeks (by 8-26-21 or at a revised date agreed upon by the City) to show delineation of existing gravel vs asphalt on site and to confirm "proposed asphalt" call-outs on the 2010 plat of survey that was submitted are no longer being proposed.
- Developer's representative also mentioned that there are stormwater facilities present on the existing site as was required by the WDNR. Please include location and details of these facilities on the site plan to be submitted.
- All stormwater facilities within the City of Waukesha require a maintenance agreement. We were unable to find a copy of the maintenance agreement on record. If an existing stormwater maintenance agreement does exist, it would need to be updated to the current template/format (see attached templates). This agreement must be approved by the board of public works and council, and then recorded at the register of deeds prior to building permit issuance. At a minimum, if the City has a signed copy of the maintenance agreement from the owner and a \$30 check payable to Waukesha County, the building permit could be approved prior to the board of public works and council approvals.
- A current BMP inspection of the stormwater facilities must also be performed at this time. See attached 2019 BMP Inspection Form.

Note: Plan sheets that we were able to dig up from back in 2010-2011 showing the original stormwater facilities design were attached and sent to developer's representative via email. This should provide a good starting point. City maintenance agreement templates and BMP inspection form were also provided via the email sent on 8-18-21.
