

#### Subject:

Please approve installation of a stop sign on Campfire Crossing and on Wyngate Way at their intersections with River Valley Road.

#### Details:

Item **ID#21-2550**: This item and items ID#21-2550 to ID#21-2557 are all associated with the same location in the Fox Ridge West and Trillium Hill neighborhoods.

This item was referred by Ald. McElderry to address current and anticipated traffic / pedestrian safety concerns on River Valley Road. In May and June of 2021, Engineering staff had conducted a traffic study of this neighborhood to develop a plan of action to address vehicular traffic and pedestrian safety issue. The study results show the subject improvements would benefit the overall traffic safety of the neighborhood. The Department of Public Works recommends approval of this item. The cost for installing a new stop signs would be around \$200.

## **Options & Alternatives:**

An extensive neighborhood traffic study was completed by staff that precipitated the subject item.

## **Financial Remarks:**

The cost for installing a new stop signs would be around \$200 and covered by the 2021 Building and Grounds Signing Budget (3310.54140).
