Recommendation: Referral was made by Public Work on behalf of a business owner at 1815 Dolphin

Drive. The business owner at 1815 has issues with semi trucks not being able to back in or pull out of their driveway during the day when cars are parked along the north side of Dolphin Drive at 1814 Dolphin. This item was brought to B&G last meeting and placed on hold. Since then, the two business owners at 1815 and 1814 have resolved the issue without needing revisions to parking. Staff requests removal of the item from

the agenda.

B. <u>ID#16-0993</u> Consider No Parking Any Time on the north side of Chicago Avenue

from Spring Street to Randall Street.

Recommendation: This referral was made by Ald. E. Payne. Residents in the area have concerns about

Chicago Avenue being a narrow street and, when nearby Blair school has student dismissal, parents line both sides of Chicago Avenue from Spring Street to Randall Street leaving a very narrow drive lane that cannot pass emergency vehicles. The request is to remove parking on the north side of Chicago Avenue from Spring Street to Randall Street to keep a clear open lane at all times. Staff supports this request and

recommends approval.

Approve No Parking Any Time at the following locations:

- north and south sides E. Sunset Drive from Tenny Avenue to 1000 feet east

- south side of E. Sunset Drive from Les Paul Parkway to 1200 feet

west

Recommendation:

This Referral was made by Public Works with approval from chairman E. Payne. In 2016, the Meijer Store and the City will be reconstructing various stretches of E. Sunset Drive from Tenny Avenue to Les Paul Parkway. When all the construction is completed, E. Sunset Drive will be 4 lanes with a median. No vehicles will be allowed to park on either side of Sunset Drive within this corridor. Staff recommends approval of the No Parking zones. The cost for installing the signs will be paid for by Meijer and by the project budget and not from Buildings & Grounds account.

The new parking zones will not go into affect until after the completion of all the

construction in November of 2016.

Recommendation:

Referral was made by Public Works with approval from chairman E. Payne. As a part of the Meijer store project, Tenny Avenue will be reconstructed from E. Sunset Drive to the south past the new store. When the construction is completed, the new roadway will be 4 lanes with a median. No vehicles will be allowed to park on either side of Tenny Avenue in this location. Staff recommends approval of the No Parking zones. The cost for installing the signs will be paid for by Meijer.

The new parking zones will not go into affect until after the Meijer Store opens in August

2016.
