Subject: Approve the Unitarian Universalist Church at 506 N. Washington Avenue to have way finding signs installed at the intersections of Summit Avenue & N. Washington Avenue and at Madison Street & N. Washington Avenue.	

Details:
This item was referred by Public Works. The Church is seeking permission to have two way finding signs installed at two locations. In the past, requests of this nature have been approved on a case-by-case basis. The Department of Public Works does not have an issue with this request as long as the Church is responsible for installing and maintaining the signing. The Church would have to get a permit with the City for installation

The Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.
