

Summer 2021 Special Event COVID Safety Considerations

Concerts, Movies, Pizza/Polka, Buchnerfest, Beer Gardens:

Safety considerations for all events:

We will follow all orders issued by our Federal, State, and Local Government. The offerings, policy and programs are subject to change at any time pending Government orders.

- Please spread out over the expansive grass area. Attendees are expected to socially distance.
- A cone grid will be set up to allow a maximum of 5 people per space (sitting close to the cone).
- Attendees will be allowed to leave the Grid to use restrooms and purchase concessions, but are asked to observe social distancing lines, respect buffer area and should not loiter in social distancing buffer zones.
- Concert grid area will open at the time listed in the description on a first come, first serve basis. To ensure concerts can continue visitors are asked not to move cones.
- Please be mindful to follow staff and volunteer requests so opportunities can continue to be offered.
- Please check the information line at 262-522-9356 as schedules may be adjusted and public safety standards may change.
- It will take everyone's cooperation to ensure a safe venue and continual offerings.

Extra Considerations:

- Pizza, Polka, Art in the Park students will pre-register to better understand attendance numbers and manage pizza distribution. General public will not be required to pre-register.
- Buchnerfest will require pre-registration.
- Civic Band/Jazz Express will not begin until mid-July and are exploring masks for musicians, school use, and evaluating musicians comfort level.
- Sneeze guards will be utilized at concession areas.

Trailbreaker

- Race will host a 5K, 10K, and Half Marathon race only and remain within the City. A virtual option is also offered.
- Runners will be sent off in waves beginning at 8:00 a.m. utilizing a cone grid.
- Runners will be masked until they begin running.
- No gathering before or after the race will take place inside of the Schuetze Recreation Center.
- Runners will take their own finisher medals from a designated area outside.
- No post-event activities will take place.

Fourth of July Fireworks (under discussion with the County)

- Show will be mostly aerial to allow for greater visibility from surrounding areas.
- Parking at the Expo will be every other spot (700) with public in parked cars remaining in their cars or the spot to their left on a first come basis (no motorcycles, motorhomes, busses, etc.).
- Socially distanced seating will be allowed on the Expo Grounds using a cone grid for walk in traffic only
 - Cone grid with maximum of five people per cone.
- Port-o-lets will be set up on the grounds and in the parking area.

Fourth of July Parade:

- Reviewing parade route with possible extension.
- Public will be asked to spread out along the route.
- Units/volunteers/staff will be required to wear masks.

Moving Wall

- Amphitheater seating will be reduced to allow for social distancing for opening and closing ceremonies.
- Allied Veterans are still planning to present the River Service and Memorial Day Parade.
