- Scheduled ARC Flash training for CWP staff and inviting other departments to attend.
- Attended meeting with DNR for potential of mixing class A compost with class A biosolids in future.

Transit

- Route 1 and Metrolift will operate a Sunday schedule on the 4th of July. No other service will
 operate.
- 2024 CIP Projects Update:
 - The New Driver Relief van-complete.
 - o Badger Drive remodel bid has been released.
 - o Badger Drive fence bid has been released.
 - The purchase order for the AC condenser has been issued and the unit is being scheduled for install later this Summer.
 - Work on removal of the first engine as part of the Bus Rehab project has started. (Picture attached)
- Staff is working on potential service changes for 2025.
- WisGo Update: Staff is targeting a roll out of WisGo for Metrolift in the Fall.
- Transit staff has finished a bus shelter policy to guide Transit on what parameters Transit should analyze to determine where bus shelters should be located and will present to the Transit Commission for approval later this Summer.
- The 2023 National Transit Database report is in final review.
- The Transit Management Services Proposals are being evaluated.
- Submitted the CIP budget and Waukesha County Transit Operating Budget.
