On July 17th at around 7:15am a city tree fell on my 2002 Lexus Is430 that was parked on the road (the car also currently has a 3 month parking permit aswell so it was legally parked on the road). The city tree did a lot of damage to the roof of the car and broke the rear driver side window and dented both driver side doors. The tree that the limb fell off of has cables in it holding it together, one of the workers that came to cut the limb that fell on the car was the one that pointed out that the tree has cables in it. The limb randomly broke off the tree and fell onto my car that was parked on the road under the tree. The weather was super clear that morning and it wasn't even windy outside either.
