

**Resolution Supporting the Wisconsin Department of Transportation
Request to Transfer Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality
Funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit
Administration on Behalf of the City of Waukesha**

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation is allocated Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grant funds for emission reduction surface transportation projects in Non-Attainment and Maintenance Areas in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation has awarded the City of Waukesha CMAQ funds through a competitive process for public transit projects; and

WHEREAS, CMAQ funds allocated for transit projects require a transfer of the funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration at the request of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City of Waukesha that

1. The City of Waukesha supports the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's request to transfer \$1,312,000 of CMAQ funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Waukesha to fund 80% of the cost of four new replacement fixed route transit buses.
