Director Damien reported on the adjustments to the 2024 CIP. The first adjustment is to the Ruben Dr. Pump Station Elimination project with an estimated budget of \$3 million. Memo for the adjustment is attached. Briefly, the consultant estimates based on the soil borings and survey work have surpassed the original estimate at \$8 million and the staff are now recommending to replace and maintain the existing pump station versus elimination.

2024 CIP included upgrading two traffic signals at Sunset Dr. and Oakland Dr. and at Sunset Dr. and Prairie Ave.. We received the grant from the DOT for the project, however, the DOT is not able to deliver the project in time for us to acquire the traffic signal equipment. We will delay upgrading the traffic signals on Sunset Dr. locations until 2025 and replacing it with the project planned for 2025, Hartwell, Broadway, and Lincoln Ave.. Internal administrative change to move the accounts. The Village has approved the project and participation at 20%.
