Review and act on the request from James De Ruyter for a one-time sewer credit for 2925 Minot Lane.

Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as filling of a swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.

James De Ruyter, on September 11, 2023, requested a credit for sewer service charges for the time period of July 2023 for a faulty timer on the outside faucet that went to the back yard. This outdoor water use was not treated by the Clean Water Plant.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was compared with the period of heavy usage.

High Usage: 82,200 gallons (2023) Average Usage: 4,000 gallons

Estimated Additional Usage: 78,200 gallons (2023) Calculated Refund (2023 - \$10.48/1000 gal): \$819.54

Options & Alternatives:

To not approve the one-time sewer credit or approve another dollar amount.
