A. [ID#17-0737](#) Please establish No Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., September 1 - June 15, Except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays on the south side of Davidson Road from east property line of 2007 Davidson Rd. to Hillcrest Dr.

**Recommendation:** This referral was made by Ald. Thieme. Persons attending the Carroll University satellite campus along Davison Road have been parking along Davidson and causing traffic congestion. The request is to have a No Parking zone installed. After further review, the parking zone recommended should have time and month restrictions to generally reflect the campus year and the school year for Hillcrest Elementary. Staff has no issues with this request and recommends approval.

B. [ID#17-0738](#) Provide a more permanent solution to pavement marking at Racine and Roberta, Endfield Estate Crossing.

**Recommendation:** This referral was made by Ald. Cummings. Residents have requested better crosswalk marking and ability to cross Racine Avenue at Roberta. An existing crosswalk exists today, but it is faded. At this time, the Department of Public Works will defer to Ald. Cummings and the Committee to discuss the level of improvement to be considered. It should be noted that Racine Avenue, at Roberta is the jurisdiction of Waukesha County and they would have to approve any upgrades. Staff recommends no action on this item or that this item be put on hold for further review.

- C. [ID#17-0875](#) Consider modifying the intersection of Market Pl. and Waterview Ln. to be an All-Way stop.
- Recommendation:** This item was referred by Ald. Manion. City staff have been working with concerned residents on Market Place who have brought many concerns forward about speeding on Market Place near Waterview Lane. There is a history of studies and measures that engineering staff conducted to review this issue. Staff conducted a speed study in 2015 and 2017 and neither study supported any evidence of excessive and continuous speeding on Market Place. Residents have now requested an All-Way stop be installed at Market Place and Waterview Lane. Public Works staff do not support the installation of an all way stop at this intersection to control speeding. Previous speed study results or traffic volumes do not support an All-Way stop.

- Recommendation:** This item was referred by Ald. Rodriguez. Concerned residents near intersection of Greenfield and Linden have expressed concern about speeding on Greenfield Ave. at Linden St. The traffic at this intersection is busy during the end of school/school bus pick up times at Hadfield School. Other traffic, in the area, attempt to avoid the congestion at the school speed down Greenfield Ave at this intersection. Engineering staff has not been able to conduct a spot speed study on Greenfield Ave to assess the level of speeding. Major construction on Arcadian and school being out soon may delay this review until September.
