<b>Subject:</b> Please approve installation of signs that say "Turning Vehicles Yield to Pedestrians" at all 4 legs of the traffic signal at the intersection of E. Main Street and Manhattan Drive.	

**Details:**  
This item was referred by Ald. Don Browne. Recent traffic complaints came through the police department about pedestrians who experience right turning traffic at the intersection that does not yield for them. The Police Department recommended placement of "Turning Vehicles Yield to Pedestrians" signs at the 4 corners of the intersection. Staff has reviewed this request and does not have any issues with it.
