I spoke with Tatiana at the day care center yesterday evening concerning the noise level on their playground area. It has once again reached unacceptable levels in an area bordering with residential housing.

Please let me know the details on when the conditional use permit comes before the board for renewal. I intend to challenge the permit and would like to make sure I'm available for the meeting.

In the meantime please let me know what other avenues I can seek to remedy this problem and who I can contact for help. I continue to be willing to work with the daycare on an acceptable compromise but it must include an earlier curfew than 6:30pm which Tatiana indicated you 2 had agreed upon and shorter hours on the week-end.

The KinderCare operation located across the street from School Care Learning Center may be a good source for guidelines and insight to working with the neighborhood. They've been in business for much longer and seem to fit in nicely with the surrounding residences. In 21 years of living in my home I've never seen or heard the KinderCare playground in use so late in the evening. Hopefully we can find a mutually satisfactory compromise. Thank you for your help.
