**Resolution Extending Paratransit Service to the Municipal Boundaries of the City of  
Waukesha**

---

**Whereas** the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires that public transit operators provide complementary paratransit service within a ¾ mile radius of its fixed routes to individuals that are unable to ride the fixed route service due to disability; and

**Whereas** the City of Waukesha Paratransit Service operated as Waukesha Metrolift has strictly adhered to the ADA required service area creating areas within the City of Waukesha ineligible for service; and

**Whereas** future changes to the fixed route service may reduce the ADA required service map creating larger areas of the City to be ineligible; and

**Whereas** the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and Federal Transit Administration allow for ADA paratransit to be operated beyond the required ADA service area; and

**Whereas** the City of Waukesha intends to make the availability of Waukesha Metrolift equitable to all City residents who qualify for the service.

**Now, therefore,** be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha that:

The City of Waukesha Paratransit Service area be extended to the municipal boundaries of the City of Waukesha.
