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Subject:

Review and act on the request from Michael and Leighann Marek for a one-time sewer credit for 1029 S. Grandview Dr.

Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as such as the filling of a swimming pool or the sprinkling of new landscape.

Michael and Leighann Marek, on July 7, 2023, requested a credit for sewer service charges for the time period of June 2023. During this period, a pool was filled.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was compared with the period of heavy usage.

High Usage: 10,900 gallons Average Usage: 6,882 gallons

Estimated Additional Usage: 4,018 gallons

Calculated Refund (2023 - \$10.48/1000 gal): \$42.11

Options & Alternatives:

To not approve the one-time sewer credit or approve another dollar amount.
