**Details:**  
12/5/2022. This item was brought forward by Ald. Frank McElderry to evaluate the intersection control at Tanglewood Drive and Stillwater Circle, Rivers Crossing Drive and Stillwater Circle, and Rivers Crossing Drive and Portage Trail.

Engineering staff have reviewed this request and will present their findings to the committee.

**Financial Remarks:**  
The cost for installing six (6) stops signs, six (6) new sign poles, twelve (12) all-way stop plaques, and twelve (12) warning flags would be around \$960 and covered by the 2022 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140).

**Executive Recommendation:**  
The Department of Public Works recommends approval to make the intersections of Tanglewood Drive and Stillwater Circle, Rivers Crossing Drive and Stillwater Circle, and Rivers Crossing Drive and Portage Trail to be all-way stop controlled.
