**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING THE
SALARIES OF ELECTIVE OFFICERS OF THE
CITY OF WAUKESHA, WISCONSIN**

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAUKESHA DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor shall be paid the salaries opposite his/her respective office in full compensation for his/her service as such officer for the period time during his/her term beginning the third Tuesday in April, 2006, and every third Tuesday in April in consecutive years 2007, 2008 and ending the third Tuesday in April, 2009:

SECTION 2. The City will pay the monthly premium cost of the group life insurance program premiums for the elected Mayor.

SECTION 3. The City will pay the monthly premium cost of the group health insurance program for the elected Mayor as provided to non-represented City employees.

SECTION 4. The City will pay the monthly premium cost of the group dental insurance program for the elected Mayor as provided to non-represented City employees.

SECTION 5. The City shall pay to the Wisconsin Retirement System for the elected Mayor the employee portion of the monthly contribution to said fund.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or contravening this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

SECTION 4. The City will pay the monthly premium cost of the group dental insurance program for the elected Mayor as provided to non-represented City employees.


