- 5. Submit copy of geotechnical report (if necessary). Confirm elevation of water table on site.
- 6. Add note that all work within City right of way and City easements to be in accordance with current City Standard Specifications and details.
- 7. Show accessible ADA route from ADA parking spot to building entrance. Will there be an accessible entrance into building?
- 8. Horizontal datum should be updated to NAD 1983/2011. See Existing Condition Survey, and City design guidelines.
- 9. Submit all required checklists for Development Submittals. See City's Development Handbook.
- 10. Provide project benchmarks on cover sheet.
- 11. Provide Development Handbook Statement on cover sheet per the checklist.
- 12. Provide sequence of construction on erosion control plan.
- 13. Provide site disturbance area.
- 14. If over an acre of disturbance additional EC measures will be required.
