Subject: Approval for Changes to Routes 2 and 9	

Details:
 This item is to seek the approval to change the routing of Routes 2 and 9. The Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market on Coral Drive in the Town of Waukesha closed on January 28th and therefore the Route 2 no longer should run there. Approving this change would also approve the elimination of the bus stop on the Wal-Mart property as it is unneeded as the store is closed.

The Route 9 change is to change the routing from W. Moreland Blvd. by the Waukesha County Courthouse in the inbound direction to Pewaukee Rd. and then North St. versus its current routing of W. Moreland Blvd. to North St. The current routing takes longer and there can be further delays by back ups caused by trains crossing E. Moreland Blvd. The proposed routing will allow the bus to bypass that area. No bus stops would be affected by the change. These changes would be effective February 17th, 2016.

Options & Alternatives:
 There is no alternative to the Route 2 change, the Wal-Mart store closed. Route 9 could remain the same but will have a greater likelihood for delays.

Financial Remarks:
 The cost associated with these changes are minimal.
