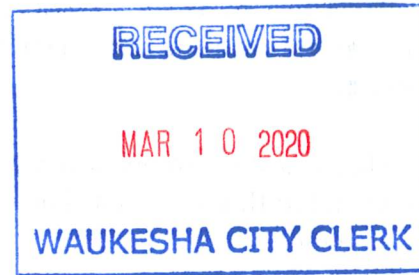

Subject: Disallowance of claim for damages filed by Billy Howled.	

<p>Details:</p> <p>See the attached notice of claim for details of the incident. The matter is under investigation. Mr. Howled was not arrested by a Waukesha Police officer. There are a <u>lot</u> of issues to be investigated and analyzed in this matter.</p> <p>A disallowance at this time does not bar recovery, it just shortens the time period in which a lawsuit can be filed. Mr. Howled's claim was not prepared by a lawyer, so his intended causes of action against the City are not clear, but if this is a section 1983 civil-rights action, it's not subject to the notice of claim statute anyway. I called the attorney Mr. Howled retained to represent him in the criminal matter, but she has not returned my call.</p>
<p>Options & Alternatives:</p> <p>The alternative is to allow the claim and to pay Mr. Howled the amount he demands. This is not recommended.</p>
<p>Financial Remarks:</p> <p>There is no financial impact from a disallowance.</p>
<p>Executive Recommendation:</p> <p>Disallow the claim and authorize the Clerk to issue a formal notice of disallowance. Our insurance company will continue to investigate and handle the matter.</p>

On January 24,2020 I Billy D Howled was arrested at my job 821 w State St, Milwaukee Wi 53233 at approximately 0900 hours due to arrest warrant that was given to the court of Waukesha on 1-14-2020 by detective Tyler Lusmann of the city of Waukesha police department.

Which wrote a criminal complaint stating that on November 29 2018 and December 3 2018 that I Billy was believe to be a person of interest in drug manufacture/cocaine on the dates listed above without doing a proper investigation that led to my arrest which was the arrest of the wrong person.

This situation in fact has caused me loss of wages at my job for me working my mandatory overtime hours to take care of myself my wife and 4 children. Embarrassment in front of the inspector of the jail coworkers' captains and lieutenants. This has caused damage to my reputation due to me being a correctional officer and being handcuffed and walked out on camera for everyone to see.

I was taken to Waukesha jail where I was striped searched and, spent approximately 10 hours in a secure cell and put on the list to go to court in between the hours listed above.

I was scheduled for court and was released on a signature bond for the amount of 1500 dollars my next court date was set for February 10,2020 and I was to comply with the Wisconsin community services pretrial supervision program were I showed up once a week and had to call the drug test line to take drug test when ordered to do so until this matter was resolved and I did exactly what was ordered.

On January 27,2020 I retained an attorney for the amount of 3,500 dollars to represent me in this matter [LASTER & ASSOCIATES, LLC 839 N. JEFFERSON ST, SUITE 310 MILWAUKEE, WI 53202.

On February 20 ,2020 an earlier court date that was set for me which I attended for all charges to be dismissed and they were dismissed without prejudice.





CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

Defendant.

The undersigned, of the Waukesha City Police Department being first duly sworn on oath, upon information and belief, states that:

Count 1: MANUFACTURE/DELIVER COCAINE (<=1G)

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, November 29, 2018, at 1019 Delafield St, Waukesha WI, in the City of Waukesha, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, did deliver a controlled substance, to-wit: Cocaine, in an amount of 1 gram or less, contrary to sec. 961.41(1)(cm)1g, 939.50(3)(g) Wis. Stats., a Class G Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than ten (10) years, or both.

And the Court may suspend the defendant's operating privileges for not less than six (6) months nor more than five (5) years. If the defendant's driving privileges are already suspended, any suspension imposed must be served consecutively.

Count 2: MANUFACTURE/DELIVER COCAINE (<=1G)

The above-named defendant on or about Monday, December 3, 2018, at 1019 Delafield St, Waukesha WI, in the City of Waukesha, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, did deliver a controlled substance, to-wit: Cocaine, in an amount of 1 gram or less, contrary to sec. 961.41(1)(cm)1g, 939.50(3)(g) Wis. Stats., a Class G Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than ten (10) years, or both.

And the Court may suspend the defendant's operating privileges for not less than six (6) months nor more than five (5) years. If the defendant's driving privileges are already suspended, any suspension imposed must be served consecutively.

STATE OF WISCONSIN - VS - Billy D Howled

PROBABLE CAUSE:

And prays that the defendant be dealt with according to law; that the basis for complainant's charge of such offense is: Based upon a review of the investigative reports written by Detective Tyler Lusmann of the City of Waukesha Police Department who is believed to be truthful and reliable in this instance.

Those reports indicate that on Thursday November 29, 2018 Detective Lusmann communicated with a confidential informant (CI) who indicated that he/she could purchase \$100 worth of crack cocaine from an unknown black male at 1019 Delafield Street, Apartment #1, in the City of Waukesha at approximately 1:30 PM. The CI indicated that the CI had contacted a black female by the name of Makciea who indicated to the CI that the black male was currently at her apartment at the above address and would sell the crack cocaine to the CI. The CI indicated that the CI called Makciea's cell phone 262-271-1741 to set up the deal.

Detective Lusmann researched the above address in his department's in house database and found that it was associated with the name Makciea Champ, he also noted that the cell phone number provided by the CI matched the phone number listed to Champ in the department's records.

Detectives met with the CI at a pre-determined location and searched the CI's person and vehicle for money, weapons, drugs and other contraband and were met with negative results. Detective Lusmann then provided the CI with \$100 in pre-recorded buy money as well with a covert listening device and a covert audio visual recording device. They then followed the CI to the target location maintaining constant visual contact until the CI arrived at 1:40 PM. At that time, Specialist Filter maintained visual contact of the CI and observed the CI enter 1019 Delafield Street, Apartment #1.

The CI exited the apartment at 1:54 PM. Specialist Filter advised that as the CI exited the residence the CI was able to positively identify Champ as the female that also exited the residence. Specialist Filter also advised that there was an unknown black male that also exited Champ's apartment at this time.

After the CI exited the residence, the CI got into the CI's vehicle and Detective Lusmann followed the CI back to a pre-determined location maintaining constant visual contact of the CI. Upon meeting with the CI, the CI turned over 3 clear plastic corner cuts containing a white, rock-type substance which based on his training and experience, Detective Lusmann believed to be crack cocaine. Detective Lusmann then searched the CI's person and vehicle again for money, weapons, drugs and any other contraband and was met with negative results. The CI indicated that the CI performed the deal with the unknown black male in the kitchen and that Champ was in the vicinity of the deal. The CI further stated that the black male then handed a crack rock to Champ after the deal with the CI was complete.

Detective Lusmann transported the suspected crack cocaine to the Waukesha Police Department where he weighed and tested the substance. The cocaine weighed 0.74 grams.

Using a Scott Reagent Pouch, Detective Lusmann tested a small portion of the substance from one of the corner cuts receiving a positive test for cocaine.

The CI provided to Detective Lusmann the unknown black males cell phone number, which was 414-349-9216. Detective Lusmann researched this number in a law enforcement database and found that it was linked to a person Laquita Moody Howled. The database further showed that a possible relative of Laquita Moody Howled was Billy D Howled. Detective Lusmann obtained Billy Howled's department of transportation photograph and compared it to the digital video of the controlled buy. He was able to positively identify Billy Howled, the above named defendant as the suspect that sold the crack cocaine to the CI.

On Monday December 3, 2018, Detective Lusmann again communicated with a CI who indicated that he/she could purchase \$100 worth of crack cocaine from a black male that the CI only knew as Brandon. The CI indicated that the CI contacted Makceia Champ via her cellphone and set up the deal. The CI stated that the deal would take place at approximately 5:30 PM at Champ's residence of 1019 Delafield Street, #1, in Waukesha.

Detective Lusmann met with the CI and searched the CI's person and vehicle for money, weapons, drugs and other contraband and was met with negative results. He then provided the CI with \$100 in pre-recorded buy money as well as a covert listening device and a covert audio/video recording device. Detectives then followed the CI to the target location maintaining constant visual contact of the CI until the CI arrived. Specialist Filter observed the CI enter apartment #1 at 5:35 PM. Several minutes later the CI exited the apartment and Detectives followed the CI back to a pre-determined meeting location maintaining constant visual contact of the CI.

Upon meeting with the CI, the CI turned over 2 clear plastic corner cuts containing a white, rock-type substance, which based on his training and experience, Detective Lusmann believed to be crack cocaine. Detective Lusmann searched the CI's person and vehicle for money, weapons, drugs and other contraband and was met with negative results.

Once at the City of Waukesha Police Department, Detective Lusmann weighed and tested the suspected crack cocaine. The substance weighed 0.87 grams. Using a Scott Reagent Pouch, Detective Lusmann tested a small portion of the substance from one of the corner cuts which tested positive for cocaine.

Detective Lusmann reviewed the digital video of the controlled buy and was able to positively identify Billy Howled, the above named defendant as the person who sold the crack cocaine to the CI. The video depicted the defendant pull a baggie out of his pants pocket, inside of the baggie were a number of crack rocks. After the defendant hands the crack cocaine to the CI in the video, the defendant tells the CI "that's a piece for 60 and another piece for 40". Based on his training and experience, Detective Lusmann knows that 60 and 40 are monetary for each of the corner cuts of crack cocaine.

Based on the foregoing, the complainant believes this complaint to be true and correct.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING PROCEDURE

While you are being drug tested by WCS, you will be assigned an ID# that tells you when to report for drug testing. Your cooperation with this program will help yourself prove that you are drug and alcohol free.

Listed below are instructions for testing while you are involved:

- 1. You have been assigned an ID# by your Case Manager. The ID# is the number "5" plus the last four digits of your social security number (see above).
2. Drug tests are conducted at Wisconsin Community Services (WCS), located at 414 W. Moreland Blvd., Suite #200, Waukesha, Wisconsin. Drug testing hours are as follows:
a. Monday through Thursday - between 7:00am and 5:00pm
b. Friday - between 7:00am and 3:00pm
c. Saturday - between 7:00am and 9:30am
d. You MUST arrive BEFORE the cutoff time. If you show up at the end of drug testing hours, you MUST be able to provide a sample immediately. You will NOT be tested outside of these drug testing hours.
3. You must call the drug testing line at 414-921-0409 or 866-207-2911 every day between the hours of 4:00am and 2:59pm. After 3:00pm, the message will change to alert you that you must call back after 4:00am for the next day's message.
4. When calling the drug testing line, you will receive the following prompts:
a. "You have reached the drug testing notification system. Press 1 for English. Press 2 for Spanish." Enter the appropriate selection.
b. "Please enter your client ID number". Enter the ID# listed above. Once your ID has been entered, there may be a short pause. Don't hang up.
c. "Does your last name begin with ..." If yes, press "1". If no, press "2".
d. You will hear one of two messages:
i. "You are required to test today" - you will need to drug test at WCS
ii. "Do not test today" - you do not need to test that day
iii. The message will be repeated three times
5. Preliminary Breath Tests or saliva testing may be conducted while you are in the office. You will not be tested you unless your mouth is empty. If you have gum, cough drops, chewing tobacco, etc., you will be instructed to wait 10 minutes before testing.
