Subject: Establish No Trucks over 3 Ton on Hamilton Avenue from N. Prairie Avenue to Franklin Avenue.	

Details:

This item was referred by Public Works. This request has come from concerned residents on Hamilton Avenue about large trucks going down Hamilton to get to Prairie Avenue. These trucks are coming and going from the Aires building. Ald. Helgestad met with concerned residents and they determined that having trucks use Franklin Avenue to W. College Avenue would be a better route. The Department of Public Works does not have an issue with this request.

The Committee voted 4 aye, 1 nay.

Options & Alternatives: None.

Financial Remarks:

The cost of installing signs for truck restriction will be about \$200 total and would be covered by the 2017 B&G Sign Budget (3310.54140).

Executive Action:

Committee Recommendation:
