- 8. Plans Administrator succession
- Determines job responsibility, training and performance of the City Administrator
- Sets standards of performance for City Administrator
- 11. Appraises organizational performance
- 12. Is a resource to, and communicates with public

## CITY ADMINISTRATOR AREAS

- 1. Accountable to Common Council & Mayor
- 2. Concerned with action decisions
- 3. Concerned with short-term decisions
- 4. Decides how to carry out objectives
- 5. Proposes policies and manages within approved policies
- 6. Proposes goals
- 7. Handles intermediate and short-term commitment of resources, organization and control
- 8. Plans managerial succession in departments
- Determines job responsibilities, training and performance with the assistance of human resources
- Sets standard of performance for Managers & Directors
- 11. Appraises operational results
- 12. Is a resource to the Common Council, keeping them informed by supplying relevant, up-to-date information on a regular basis
