Pool Passes

Pool pass purchases decreased this year due to the cool weather. The Ultimate Group Pass continues to be the most popular pass sold; this pass includes slide usage at HSAC. The pool pass revenue is split between the two pools, according to the 2013 patron pool preference: Horeb 57% and Buchner 43%.
