#### Subject:

Review and act on the request from David Wellner for a one-time sewer credit for 1840 Waterview Ln.

## Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as such as the filling of a swimming pool or the sprinkling of new landscape.

David Wellner, on July 21, 2023, requested a credit for sewer service charges for the time period of July 2023. During this period, a pool was filled.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was compared with the period of heavy usage.

High Usage: 11,400 gallons Average Usage: 4,418 gallons

Estimated Additional Usage: 6,982 gallons

Calculated Refund (2023 - \$10.48 /1000 gal): \$73.17
