<b>Subject:</b> Approval of Resolution Authorizing the Filing of the 2019 Federal Certifications and Assurances	

**Details:**  
 This item is to seek the approval of the resolution authorizing the Transit Manager to file the 2019 Federal Certifications and Assurances. In order to receive federal funds, every year the Transit Commission must file that it agrees to the applicable federal certifications and assurances. This authorization is typically included in a grant authorization resolution but there are no new grant resolutions scheduled in the near future. Federal regulations require the certifications and assurances to be filed no later than 90 days past the posting date of the certifications and assurances. The posting date this year was March 13th.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
 No alternative. Filing is a requirement to receive federal funds.

**Financial Remarks:**  
 The filing of the certifications and assurances are required in order to receive federal grant funds. About 10% of the City and County transit operating funds come from federal funds and 80% of capital funds come from federal sources.
