On behalf of the Waukesha Tennis Association (WTA) thank you for implementing the current tennis court policy allowing for singles play. Players have been instructed to practice social distancing of 6 feet as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control.

The WTA has been monitoring the player conduct at the Woyahn Tennis Center at Heyer Park multiple times each day for the past week. We have found that on each occasion, the social distancing policy has been maintained by the tennis players.

We ask that you consider allowing for doubles play, so long as there is no physical contact between players and social distancing is obeyed. We feel that the dimensions of the tennis court, which is 78 feet long by 36 feet wide in doubles, inherently allows for a sufficient amount of space for tennis players to actively maintain 6 feet of safe social distancing.
