Now, therefore, the Common Council resolves that the Vacant Land Sale Contract, executed by the Mayor, City Clerk and Finance Director on behalf of the City on June 30, 2016, and executed by The Very Reverend Curt J. Frederick on behalf of St. John Neumann Congregation on June 27, 2016, is approved and ratified in all respects, and that the Mayor is directed and authorized to close the purchase transaction without delay.
