• The Fire Department received their new UTV ambulance. It was used for the Main Street Parade Memorial Dedication and will be used this weekend for the Night of Lights and Christmas Parade. The UTV Ambulance helps ensure that medical assistance can reach you wherever you are, whether it's a remote area or a crowded event. With most of the same lifesaving equipment as a regular ambulance, this vehicle can also still offer patient privacy in a fully enclosed patient compartment with room for a full-sized cot.

- Finished monthly DNR Discharge Monitoring Report for October.
- Continuing successful return flow pumping to Root River.
- Finished semi-annual biosolids land application.
- Met with Jacobs on pharmaceuticals and personal care products source reduction plan.

TRANSIT:

• WisGo cards are being distributed free at the Transit Center until through December 29th. The cards are available for passengers that either cannot use or prefer not to use the mobile app. The cards are re-loadable and can be done by the passenger on the passenger portal www.umopass.com or they can re-loaded with value at Waukesha area retailers including: Walgreens, CVS, Kwik Trip, and Speedway stores, as well as the Waukesha Walmart and the Transit Center. Existing fare media will be sold through December 31, 2023, and must be used by April 30, 2024. Effective January 1, 2024, only WisGo cards will be sold for fare media.

- Completed submittals for 2023 WisDOT Management Review which is a review WisDOT does every 5 years. Review meeting will be scheduled for December 6th.
- Working on the 2024 WisDOT Mass Transit Operating Assistance application.
- Started planning work for approved 2024 CIP projects. The New Driver Relief van has been ordered with a to be determined delivery date in 2024. Design work on the Badger Drive remodel will begin soon.
