## **RESOLUTION 2024**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin that the Board of Public Works in conformity with Chapter 349 Wisconsin Statutes shall place the following official trafficsigns and signals at the intersections and upon the highways indicated; that said signs and signals shall be so located as to give adequate warning to users of the highway and no provision of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Waukesha, with respect thereto, shall be enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

The following resolution was approved at the May 6, 2024, Building and Grounds meeting and brought forward to the May 21, 2024, Common Council Meeting for approval under the Consent Agenda.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.

ID#24-9587 - Establish a handicap parking zone on the northwest side of White Rock Avenue from the center of the doors to Trinity Lutheran Church (#1052) to a point 25 feet northeast and to a point 25 feet southwest. Temporarily remove the two-hour parking zone from 7am-4pm except Saturday, Sunday, and Holiday on the northwest side of White Rock Avenue from a point 40 feet northeast of the entrance to Trinity Lutheran Church to 385 feet southwest from mid-May to mid-August of this year.
