Staff gave a presentation on the traffic and crash data. The accident rate is fairly low. However, it is noted that the vehicle crashes have only been recorded up to June of 2021. Residents present indicated more crashes happened just recently. The report also showed that there is a speeding issue of, generally, 10 MPH over the 85 percentile speed.

One comment from residents that does appear in the report was that the street lighting is very faint and they want more lighting at the intersection. The committee discussed the report findings and instructed staff to do the following:

- 1. Send speed data to the Police Department so they can review and adjust a patrol strategy.
- 2. Review the street lighting and work with Ald. Moltzan to make a referral at next Building and Grounds meeting for light increase.
- 3. As a matter of maintenance, staff should instruct the City Garage to replace any worn out signing on the Racine Avenue corridor and trim trees that are covering signs or lighting.

Approve the installation of the stop sign for the southbound traffic on NW Barstow Street at the intersection with Buena Vista Avenue.

> Staff gave a presentation on the traffic and crash data. The accident rate is fairly close to 1.0 MEV and rises to the level of concern. Staff indicated that installing a 3-way stop condition with stops on Buena Vista Avenue and the southbound Barstow Street approach would benefit the intersection. The northbound approach of Barstow Street would not stop. The committee agreed with this finding and Ald. E. Payne will make a referral to request installation of a 3-way stop condition.
