

Board of Public Works rejects Waukesha library canopy renovation bids

WAUKESHA — The Board of Public Works voted to reject bids received for the Waukesha Public Library's exterior entrance canopy renovation on Thursday.

Director of Public Works Fred Abadi explained the bids received were way over budget.

According to city documents, the budgeted amount for the pro-

ject is \$525,000. The lowest bid came in at \$780,541. The highest came in at \$829,625.

"The library is planning to include this in their request for 2021 CIP and do it as part of a bigger project," Abadi said at the meeting.

Committee members voted unanimously to reject the bids..
