Reporting Relationships:

Reports directly to the Building Maintenance Supervisor first or second shift as needed.

Length of Employment:

Minimum of 20 weeks but not to exceed 6 consecutive months within a calendar year per union contract item 7.08., item A. These employees would work only between the months of April and October, first or second shift as needed.

Experience:

A minimum of 3 summer seasons of work experience in the department or comparable experience in building maintenance doing comparable work. Preferred experience in pool operations. CPO or AFO certification helpful. Must have experience in plumbing, electrical, or construction and custodial work.

Responsibilities include:

- Cleaning and maintenance of facilities
- Pool maintenance
- Opening and closing of park shelters
- Operating vans, pickups, small dump trucks
- Repairing of light fixtures
- Painting buildings and signs
- Completing work assignments by working independently or without direct supervision
- Demonstrate and set an example regarding proper equipment maintenance and proper public relations skills.
