Subject: Review and act on the Consulting Contract for the West Side Pump Station Consolidation Analysis and Design project.	

Details:

In 2014, the City completed a feasibility study to determine if it was possible to eliminate three pump stations on the west side of the City by routing the flows to an existing pump station on Madison Street. The results of that study showed that it was feasible. The elimination of the three pump stations will require the installation of additional gravity sewers, the extension of a force main, and upgrades to the existing Madison Street Pump Station.

The Department of Public Works solicited proposals from consultants to provide engineering design services for this work. The request was sent out to nine consultants and two responded with proposals. After reviewing the proposals, the City's review team chose Donohue and Associates. See the attached memo with this recommendation and the rankings of the consultants. The scope of their services is attached with a Lump Sum price of \$199,840.00.

Options & Alternatives:

The other consultant could be chosen, but Donohue & Associates is recommended due to their experience and expertise along with the cost considerations. Donohue & Associates has completed this type of engineering work for the City in the past.
