<b>Subject:</b> Review and act on the Scope of Services for the Engineering Services for the Analysis and Design of Storm Sewer and Flood Mitigation – Area 5.	

**Details:**  
 The purpose of the Area 5 storm sewer improvements is to mitigate flooding at the intersection of S. Washington Avenue and Lawndale, the Intersection of Lawndale and Hine Avenue, through the back yards of residences down to Hine Avenue, and along Millwood Lane and American Way to the outfall in Woodfield Park. The sewer is being designed to coordinate construction with other projects in the area. The Engineering Division has worked with the consultant to develop the final scope of services (see attached).

Donohue and Associates, Inc. and their rates for engineering services were approved by the Board of Public Works on October 5, 2017.

The final contract will be reviewed by the attorney's office prior to signing.
