- A. [ID#19-1125](#) Please review and consider rush hour and overnight parking restrictions on Springdale Road from Bluemound Road to E. Moreland Blvd.
Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Ald. Browne and originally placed on the August 19, 2019, Building and Grounds agenda and held until October 14, 2019. Staff is coordinating this item with Ald. Browne. To aid in this review, engineering staff has completed the following:

- * Conducted an ADT (average daily traffic) study
- * Conducted a spot speed study
- * Reviewed existing signing on the corridor

This information will be presented at the Building and Grounds meeting. At this time, the Department of Public Works does not have any specific recommendations. It is noted, however, that some signing, which might aid in traffic behavior and flow, could be installed and the committee may consider this at their meeting.

Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Ald. E. Payne to revamp the parking zone on west side of Mountain Avenue adjacent to the hospital. The cost for this signing will be around \$150.

- C.** [ID#19-1356](#) Please modify the 30 Minute parking zone for the 3 stalls on W. Main Street, in front of the Clarke Hotel to have 3 individual parking signs for each stall that say 30 Minute Parking, This Stall Only.

Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Public Works and Ald. Miller to modify the parking zone signing layouts to better inform vehicles parking that the 3 stalls in front of the Clarke Hotel are designated as 30 minute parking only. The current signing arrangement creates some confusion. The modification will require new posts and signs. The cost for this signing will be around \$150.

- E.** [ID#19-1358](#) Please adjust the placement of the "No Parking Here to Drive" signs on east side of N. University Drive to be the following:
A.) At the southern most driveway to Linden Grove to be 50 feet south of center of driveway.
B.) At the northern most driveway to Linden Grove to be 50 feet south of center of driveway.

Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Public Works and Transit. Transit had recently removed 2 bus stops on N. University Drive north of Michigan Avenue near the Linden Grove complex. With removal of the bus stops, the existing allowable parking can be modified accordingly. No Parking for the former bus stops is being proposed to be adjusted to be approximately 50 feet from the driveways described above instead of 80 to 100 feet. The cost for this signing will be around \$100.
