Resolution Adopting the Waukesha County All-Hazards Mitigation Plan

Whereas the City of Waukesha recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

Whereas undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

Whereas an adopted all-hazards mitigation plan is required by FEMA as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects under FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas the City of Waukesha participated jointly in the planning and update process with Waukesha County and other local units of government in the creation of an all-hazards mitigation plan, which was made available for review and shall be kept permanently by the Waukesha County Office of Emergency Management; and

Whereas officials of the Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region V, reviewed updates to the plan in 2016 and approved it contingent upon this official adoption by the participating governing body; and

Whereas the adoption of an all-hazards mitigation plan by the City of Waukesha will have no fiscal impact on the City;

Now, therefore, the Common Council of the City of Waukesha hereby resolves that the 2016 Waukesha County All-Hazards Mitigation Plan is adopted by the City as the City's official plan, and that the City shall participate in the implementation of the Plan as it applies to this jurisdiction.
