Subject: Rescind the previously established April 7, 2009, Parking Zone that states: "No Parking, 2 a.m. to 9 a.m. Saturdays, May 9 to October 31, Tow Away Zone" which exists on north and south sides of Parking Lot 1. Said areas will revert to standard 3 hour parking 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.	

Details:
This item was referred by Public Works on behalf of the police department and Ald. Helgestad. With the relocation of Farmers Market to a new location along St. Paul Avenue, the "tow away" zone signing is no longer needed on Riverfront Street. The request is to rescind the subject tow away zone and allows this area to revert back to regular 3 hour parking. At total of 4 signs would be removed. Staff recommends approval of this item.

The Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.

Options & Alternatives: Another option is to leave the tow away zone in place. However, the police department will have to issue tickets for anyone parking there on a Saturday. Those stalls can be used for persons parking to attend farmers market on Madison Street.

Financial Remarks:
Removal of signing related to this will not incur cost except for city garage personnel time.

Executive Action:
If approved by Council, the resolution for approving the installation of these signs will need to be executed by the Mayor and Clerk after the Council Meeting.

Committee Recommendation:
The Buildings and Grounds Committee approved this item at their May 15, 2017 meeting. This item will appear under the Consent Agenda for the June 6, 2017 council meeting.
