<b>Subject:</b> Review and act on Amendment No. 1 to the two-party State Municipal Agreement between the City of Waukesha and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the LRIP-D Supplement (previously MLS Grant) for the reconstruction of N. Prairie Avenue between W. St Paul Avenue and College Avenue.	

**Details:**  
 Previously reviewed, the City was awarded an MLS Grant through the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) for the reconstruction of N. Prairie Avenue. On July 10, 2020, the Wisconsin Supreme Court overturned and voided the MLS Grant program. On July 27, 2020, WisDOT LRIP Committee met and voted to fund all of the previously funded MLS Grants that met LRIP requirements, which the City's N. Prairie Avenue meets these requirements. Attached for review is the amended two-party contract between the City and WisDOT.
