Resolution Directing the Board of Public Works to Commence 2026 CIP Projects

Whereas on September 16, 2025, the Common Council passed its 2026 CIP Budget, containing appropriations for a number of Public Works projects; and

Whereas the Board of Public Works is authorized by Wis. Stat. §62.15 to prepare plans and specifications for those public works projects, and to advertise for bids for such projects;

Now therefore, the Common Council of the City of Waukesha resolve that the Board of Public Works is authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for bids for the construction of the following 2026 CIP Projects approved by the Common Council:
