





Public Comment Themes: Fixed Route

Overall support for restructured Waukesha Metro Routes

Request for longer service hours and greater frequency – especially on Route 1 and extensions

Support to continue Route 9 service to WCTC

Some comments requested service reductions or smaller buses due to low ridership

- "I would love it if the transit system could incorporate after school activities (West High School) in the bus schedule"
- "Quicker routes please"
- ➤ "Right now there is insufficient transportation for those partaking in 2nd and 3rd shift jobs"
- ➤ "It is more important than ever that WCTC service on the Bus 9 is extended until later in the evening than currently "
- route [15], but a smaller half size bus would make much more sense"











•••• Vehicle Size Options



- Current 35-foot buses are the shortest bus that meet Metro's service needs for longevity
- ➤ Minimal cost difference between 35-foot and 30foot vehicles (about \$5,500)
- Certain routes and group/school trips require higher capacity buses











Public Comment Themes: On-demand

Support for on-demand options to improve access

Interest in on-demand transportation for students and seniors

Businesses expressed support for evening and weekend options

- This would open access to opportunities for our adults seeking employment and services that might not need regular transportation to a location"
- "Definitely worth pursuing"
- This seems it may be a good way to continue to help those riders who may have a disability"
- ➤ "As long as it saves money"











Public Comment Themes: Paratransit

Overall support for paratransit and specialized transportation

Some interest in countywide shared-ride taxi

Concerns about cost and who pays

- This is a valid service for taxpayers to participate in. Keeping access to services and shops for the elderly and disabled should be a priority"
- "The paratransit service should run like Washington County Taxi and allow abled-bodied people to ride for a higher cost"











Recommendations and Options

- The transit plan includes the list of recommendations and which entity(ies) would implement them
- ➤ Organized in three main sections or "elements"
 - 1. Fixed-Route Transit Service
 - 2. On-Demand Transportation Service
 - 3. Paratransit and Specialized Transportation Service











Current Waukesha Metro Routes




Image of existing Waukesha Metro Routes shown in Chapter 2

Restructured Waukesha Metro Routes




Image of recommended weekday Waukesha Metro Routes

- Straightening Route 1 and supplemental changes to nearby routes
- Reduces service hours and travel time
- Weekend route changes to serve major trip generators
- Future ridership will determine further changes












Waukesha Metro Changes: Routes 1 and 3



















Waukesha Metro Changes: Routes 5, 6, and 7











- ➤ Mobility hubs




Image of FlexRide Milwaukee ride request app

Existing route performance












On-Demand Service Limitations

Creating a larger on-demand zone has tradeoffs that may outweigh the potential benefits of the service design.













Paratransit & Specialized Transportation Element

- ➤ Recommends continued collaboration with the Aging and Disability Resource Center of Waukesha County
- Recommendation is consistent with the Waukesha County Specialized Transportation Program Review Study (August 2022)
 - Short-term resume quarterly transportation coordination meetings
 - Medium-term identify improvements (e.g., technology pilot or service standards)
- Identifies topics and steps to consider if paratransit service would be combined in the future
- ➤Out of scope County shared-ride taxi
 - Identifies service characteristics to consider if pursued in the future
