- A. [ID#16-132](#) Request of Waukesha Downtown Business Association to close Municipal Parking Lot 1 for the Farmers Market every Saturday May 7, 2016 to Saturday October 29, 2016 from 5:00 am to 2:00 pm. This closing would include permission to tow vehicles from the area.

The committee discussed this item. Several persons representing the WBA and vendors of the Farmers Market spoke about the topic. The committee decided to call for a vote to deny this item because a different venue is being considered to host the Farmers Market and the merchants on W. Main Street have requested Municipal Lot 1 to be available for general parking to help offset the loss of parking on W. Main Street during the construction project. If the vote to deny passes, this item will appear on the Buildings & Grounds Committee report on the February 18, 2016 Council agenda.
