**Resolution Supporting the Wisconsin Department of Transportation
Request to Transfer Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Funds from the Federal
Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on Behalf of the
City of Waukesha**

Whereas the Wisconsin Department of Transportation has allocated Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grant funds for congestion mitigation and air quality (CMAQ) projects in Milwaukee Urbanized Area; and

Whereas the Wisconsin Department of Transportation has awarded the City of Waukesha CMAQ funds in the amount of \$222,400 through a competitive process to fund public transit projects; and

Whereas CMAQ funds allocated for transit projects require a transfer of the funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration; and

Whereas the Wisconsin Department of Transportation will request the transfer of funds; and

Whereas the City of Waukesha intends to apply the CMAQ funds to fund the replacement of bus engines.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha that:

The City of Waukesha supports a request by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to transfer \$222,400 of CMAQ funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Waukesha to fund 80% of the cost of replacement bus engines.
