As part of developing the request for a review of our EMS fees, the fees charged by other communities served by Andres Medical Billing (AMB) was considered. According to the information provided to us, charges range as follows (approximately 282 communities throughout the mid-west were included):

In reviewing the information provided, it is challenging to compare communities. AMB has stressed the need to consider the philosophy of the community and the charges reimbursed by insurance and whether a soft collection policy is in place.
