# Subject:

Approval and authorization of contract between City of Waukesha and Carrico Aquatic Resources, Inc. for Pool Maintenance Services.

### Details:

Waukesha Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department (WPRF) is contracting with Carrico Aquatic Resources, Inc. to provide operation and maintenance assistance and consultation for both of the City's aquatic facilities, Horeb Springs Aquatic Center and Buchner Pool. This is the same contract that was in place for the past two year. Services provided include routine testing of equipment and water chemistry, issuing monthly reports, providing all chemicals and equipment to maintain the water chemistry, unlimited phone and onsite consultation, provide detailed chemistry plans. The City Attorney and Carrico Aquatic Resources, Inc. staff have reviewed and approved this contract.

# **Options & Alternatives:**

WPRF staff considers contracting with Carrico Aquatic Resources, Inc. to be the most efficient and cost effective method to maintain quality water chemistry at the aquatic facilities, due to their expertise and experience.

### **Financial Remarks:**

The contract amount is \$27,000, which is the price held from the previous two years. This is budgeted for with \$17,000 coming from the Horeb Springs Aquatic Center other professional services (5325.52190) and \$10,000 from the Buchner Pool other professional services (5320.52190).

# **Executive Action:**

Recommend approval of the contract between City of Waukesha and Carrico Aquatic Resources, Inc. and authorize the Mayor to enter into this contract.

### Committee Recommendation:

The Parks, Recreation & Forestry Board unanimously approved this contract on September 21, 2015.
