WHEREAS, advocacy groups as well as public and private organizations across the country have endorsed the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small Business Saturday.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Shawn Reilly, Mayor of the City of Waukesha, do hereby proclaim November 28, 2015, as:
