Existing 3 car garage is aproximately 27' wide by 20' deep. We would like to take existing garage down and replace with a new 2 car garage that is 24' wide by 22' deep. current and new garage may take up more then 20% of backyard. Current garage side is also 6" to 18" on an angle from current property line. It is also used as a fencby the neighbors.

- 1. The house was built in the 1930s when houses, rooms, garages and lots were much smaller then today. Pulling into garages the angle is tight with tight driveway and not a lot of turning radius. It would be easier to have garage closer to where it is today.
- 2. The yard is set up nice wher we have one outdoor parking space that will not block garage access. Also it is nice to have more room on the right side to get in to the back yard and for gardening.
- 3. A new garage would probally increase property value, but we are requesting variance just for the purpose of replacing the old garage with modern garage.
- 4. I have fortified old garage and braced internally for safety and structual integrity, I feel the old garage still has 10 years left in it, however I feel the fire inspector would disagree with me on this, so maybe it is time to replace.
