



COUNTY DEMOCRAT — This was the second Waukesha County Democrat to be published here. This one lasted from 1872 to 1900, when it merged with the Waukesha Freeman, as the Dispatch did later. This picture was taken in 1885, when steam power was the modern method of operating printing equipment. Before that it was operated by hand. This building was located where Becker's Sporting Goods

store is now, 318 W. Broadway. The paper was printed upstairs. At left in upstairs window is Judge J. R. Spencer, and Democrat employes peer from the other windows. Standing at top step in doorway at left is Judge Patrick H. Carney, Democrat editor. Pat Coyle, owner of Coyle's saloon on first floor, is standing in doorway in center of building. To his left is Ed Wells, barber. The two at left are unidentified.
