Review

The property is currently served by a dead end water main. This water main froze last winter, which caused 1537 E. Moreland Blvd to be without fire protection for several weeks. An easement was recently obtained to allow this water main to be looped to a water main in the neighboring property and construction is planned for some time in September/October 2014. During construction, and as allowed by the easement, traffic through the access drive behind the building will be interrupted. Until this looping can be completed, fire protection for this property could be compromised.

addition of water using fixtures.
