Subject: To recommend approval of the agreement with Wisconsin Adaptive Sports Association for a sled hockey demonstration and public "try-it" activity associated with the 2023 City of Waukesha JanBoree public event.	

Details:
Waukesha Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department (WPRF) is working collaboratively with various organizations across the Waukesha community to host the Waukesha JanBoree, January 13-22, 2023. This event offers nearly 50 free activities to attendees. One of the activities offered will be a sled hockey demonstration by the Wisconsin Adaptive Sports Association on the ice at Lowell Park. The public will have the opportunity to learn about adaptive sports and try out the sleds.

Options & Alternatives:
Staff recommendation is to work cooperatively with the Wisconsin Adaptive Sports Association to provide the sled hockey demonstration and allow the public to learn more about adaptive sports in our community. The alternative would be to not host the activity.

Financial Remarks:
There is no additional financial investment for the City. WPRF already makes the ice rink at Lowell Park that will be used for this event. Wisconsin Adaptive Sports Association will be a partner in the Waukesha JanBoree and will not receive compensation for this activity

Executive Recommendation:
Recommend approval of the contract between City of Waukesha and Wisconsin Adaptive Sports Association and authorize the Mayor to enter into this contract.
