Subject: The Fire Department is requesting permission to allow Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus to list, market and broker the sale of the Fire Department's 1992 E-One Aerial Platform. The term of the listing would be for 6 months.	

Details:
In preparation for the upcoming replacement of the Department's 1992 E-One Aerial Platform, Department Staff researched alternatives to seek a wider market and potentially greater return on the disposal of the Apparatus. The Listing and Marketing Commission Agreement is attached and has been reviewed by the City Attorney and Finance Staff. The term of the agreement that we are recommending would be for 6 months, and if we are unable to find an acceptable sale, the department would dispose of the apparatus through traditional methods. Locally, the City of Pewaukee and the Town of Brookfield have recently utilized the firm to dispose of their aerial ladders that they have replaced and had great success with the services provided by Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus. Staff will be available at the meeting to discuss this item.

Options & Alternatives:
The Common Council could elect to deny the request. This would leave in place the current practice of disposing the property utilizing Wisconsin Surplus Online Auctions.
